



## **ADJUSTING CHLORINE AND pH TARGETS**

## Pool Lab has the default targets set at: Free Chlorine: 2.0 | pH: 7.6

Australian regulations require a free chlorine level of between 1 and 3ppm. Pool Lab recommends between 2 and 3ppm to ensure safe and trouble-free swimming.

The correct pH level is determined by a combination of the type of the pools' interior finish and balancing with the <u>Langlier Saturation Index</u>.

Consult a pool professional to establish the correct pH level for your pool.

To adjust free chlorine and/or pH targets:

1. Press the **VIEW** button to bring up the home screen:



2. Hold the **VIEW** button in for five seconds to enter the settings menu:



3. Ensure asterisk is next to SETTINGS as per the image above. Press **VIEW** button to enter targets menu:



- 4. Use **UP** or **DOWN** button to select CL or PH with asterisk. Press **VIEW** button and value will start flashing. Use **UP** or **DOWN** button to adjust target to desired setting, then press **VIEW** button to lock value in (flashing will stop).
- 5. Use **BACK** button to return to the home screen.
